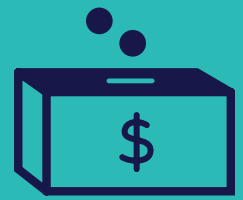


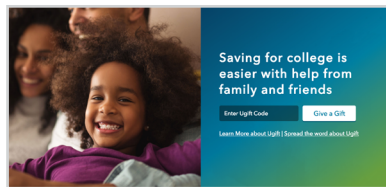
How Friends & Family Can Help You Save in Your Child's College Savings Account



If you have a NY 529 **Direct Plan Account**, friends and family can make a deposit for your child by using Ugift®. You can find your child's Ugift® code by logging in to your account at nysaves.org and clicking "Share Ugift code and view history of gifts." After you have found your code, share the code and the instructions below with your friends and family. A deposit for their education makes a great birthday or holiday gift, and reminds them that their community is supporting their dreams for the future.

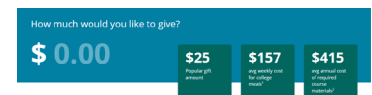
Step 1

Log on to Ugift529.com, enter the recipient's Ugift® code and click "Give a Gift."



Step 2

Enter the amount you want to donate in the "Gift Amount" field. The account holder's information will be filled in automatically after having entered a valid Ugift® code in step 1.

Step 3

Scroll down to enter your first name, last name, email, and phone number, and then click "Continue."

Step 4

Select whether you want to make your donation electronically via your bank account or by check and click "Continue."

Step 5

If you selected "Bank Account," fill in your Bank Name, Account Number, and Account Type, and click "Continue" to make your contribution. If you selected "Mail Check," you will be shown a review page before sending the check.

If you have an Amalgamated Save for College Bank Account, friends and family can make a deposit for your child by writing a check or money order, or by giving you cash:

- Contributions in **cash** should be given to the account holder who will deposit the amount in person.
- Contributions by **check** and **money order** should be made out to the name of the account holder:
 - In the memo field, write the recipient's Amalgamated Save for College Bank Account number.
 - Give the check or money order to the account holder who will deposit it in person.
