
Follow the instructions below to receive contributions to your NY 529 *Direct Plan* or Amalgamated Save for College Bank Accounts.

## How to Receive Contributions to your NY 529 Direct Plan Account

If you own a NY 529 *Direct Plan* account, you can collect contributions using Ugift®—a website that allows anyone to contribute donations to your plan following a few simple steps. If you have questions about Ugift, call 1.877.914.4839.


### Step 1

To receive contributions, you have to provide donors with your Ugift® code. To find your code, log on to your 529 account at <a href="mailto:nysaves.org">nysaves.org</a> and click "Share Ugift® code and view history of gifts". You can email your code to friends and family, include it on party invitations, or share it via social media.



#### Step 2

Once they have your code, your friends and family can log on to Ugift529.com; enter the code, their name, and the gift amount; and choose whether they want to make their gift electronically or by check.



The code makes the transaction secure, but the gift givers won't have to register for or log on to the site. And they won't have to pay a service fee, as some programs charge. They'll see a confirmation after making their gift, and they can also choose to receive a confirmation by email. You'll get a confirmation too.

### How to Receive Contributions to your Traditional College Savings Account

If you own a college savings account with Amalgamated Bank, you can receive contributions in via check, cash or money order.

#### **Option 1 - Check or Money Order**

To receive contributions via check or money order, provide your donor with your name and account number. Your child's Champion will need to go to their nearest bank branch to deposit money for your child using a check.

#### **Option 2 - Cash or Money Order**
