



Save for College Program Virtual Workshop: Choose the Right College and Career Savings Account



This year, through the NYC Kids RISE Save for College Program, every kindergarten and first grade student* enrolled in an NYC public school (including participating charter schools) automatically receives an NYC Scholarship Account with initial funds from NYC Kids RISE (and opportunities to earn more over time), unless their families choose not to participate.

After activating and viewing your child's NYC Scholarship Account (Building Block 1), you can open your own college and career savings account (Building Block 2). When you connect the accounts, NYC Kids RISE will put another \$25 reward toward your child's NYC Scholarship Account.

Join this workshop to learn about these savings account options—NY 529 *Direct Plan* Account or a College and Career Savings Account from Amalgamated Bank - so you can choose the one that best fits your family's needs!
