The NYC Kids RISE Save for College Program is a scholarship and savings program designed to make college and career training more accessible for public school students.

This school year, every kindergarten, first grade, and second grade student enrolled in NYC public schools (including participating charter schools) can join the Program, no matter their family income or immigration status.

Eligible children are automatically enrolled and receive a free NYC Scholarship Account with an initial \$100 unless their parents or guardians choose not to participate.
