



Save for College Program Virtual Workshop: Choose the Right College and Career Savings Account



In school year 2023-2024, kindergarten, first grade, and second grade students at NYC public schools (including participating charter schools) can join the Program, no matter their family income or immigration status.

Eligible children are automatically enrolled and receive a free NYC Scholarship Account with an initial \$100 unless their parents or guardians choose not to participate and opt out.

After activating and viewing your child's NYC Scholarship Account (Building Block 1), you can open your own college and career savings account (Building Block 2). When you connect the accounts, NYC Kids RISE will put another \$25 reward toward your child's NYC Scholarship Account.

Join this workshop to learn about these savings account options - NY 529 Direct Plan Account or a College and Career Savings Account from Amalgamated Bank - so you can choose the one that best fits your family's needs!
